

Explore the mountains on a four-hour round trip to the High Falls of Cheat in our smooth, climatecontrolled and diesel powered passenger train, the New Tygart Flyer. Need more adventure? Take the six-hour excursion into high mountain country to Spruce on the 1920 vintage Cheat Mountain Salamander. Both excursions depart Elkins and offer scenic vistas of rivers, mountain valleys, and a passage through a wooden



"S" curve tunnel built beneath Cheat Mountain.

On scheduled evenings, enjoy a four-course meal on the 4-hour Mountain Explorer Dinner train. This fulfilling adventure sometimes comes packaged with a Murder Mystery show.

In Nearby Durbin

Board Old #3, the Durbin Rocket, one of only three operating Climax geared logging locomotives on earth, to chug along the beautiful Greenbrier River. This steam-driven locomotive offers open-car views and closed-car comfort. If you're the ultimate adventure seeker...stay overnight at the end of the line in a fully equipped Castaway Caboose.

Departing the historic depots of Elkins and Durbin April through December, the Durbin & Greenbrier Valley Railroad also offers a full schedule of special train events and in November/ December, the ever-popular Polar Express™ departs Elkins.

Shopping & Dining

Both Depots house gift shops loaded with rail souvenirs, and the RailYard Restaurant, adjacent to the Elkins Depot, hosts a casual dining experience before or after your ride.

Nestled between the Continental Divide and the shadow of Seneca Rocks, the unique mountain landscape found in the Randolph County region, is home to a wealth of natural wonders like the Monongahela National Forest, Dolly Sods Scenic Area, Spruce Knob, the highest point in the state, and Blackwater Falls State Park.

Specially constructed trails let mountain bikers have "epic rides" while hikers, not intimidated by great mountain landscapes, can go out into the backcountry as far as they like.

The Highlands Trail provides 25 miles of an exceptionally scenic trail with panoramic views of the West Virginia countryside as it passes through a mountainous region with small towns and rural farmland. For more information, go to www.highlandstrail.org



Elkins Raceway – Born out of Moonshine running, stock car racing is a passion for many at the local dirt track. Just outside of Elkins on Rt. 219 north.


Monongahela National Forest – Nestled in the Appalachian Mountains of West Virginia, Randolph County is a natural paradise for outdoor enthusiasts.
